# EGGPLANT

## BLACK NITE

Tender large purple-black fruit Ideal for traditional dishes. Pick while still glossy



## Casper

Large, white and early fruit on a compact, high yielding bush. Perfect for small gardens. Sweet, smoky flavour



## Diamond

An open-pollinated variety that crops well in cooler climates. Small, black, elongated globes



## Early Long Purple

Quick maturing, long, slender, dark purple fruit. Harvest young for increased tenderness.



## Di Listada Di Gandia

Early Italian heirloom. Stunning 15-20cm fruit is a brilliant glossy purple with white stripes



## ROSA BIANCA

Beautiful Italian heirloom. Large, plump, round, white fruit, blushed with rosy pink.



## Russian Matrosik

Gorgeous purple & white striped, medium-sized, elongated fruit. Mild flavour, suits cooler climate.



## Slim Jim

Early maturing, rich, purple, cocktail-sized fruit. A favourite of ours for flavour and ease of use.



## Thai KERMIT

Golf ball sized fruit. Can be eaten fresh or cooked, it's used in many Asian dishes



## Thai Long Green

Prolific producer of long, pale green fruit, perfect for Thai dishes. Mild, tender flesh absorbs spicy flavours well.



## VIOLETTA DI FIRENZE

Plump, classic Italian heirloom variety. Ruffled, teardrop-shaped fruit with creamy, bitterless texture.



# CHILLI

## ANAHEIM

15-20cm tapered, mild heat. Dark green maturing to glossy red



## AUSTRALIAN BANANA

Slim, yellow, ripening to red. Hot & very high yielding.



## BIG JIM

Large red chillies up to 25cm long. Prolific. Prefer warm conditions.



## YELLOW SIAM

These chillies have an amazing rich golden yellow / orange colour to them when ripe and are quite spicy. They make a beautifully fragrant powder.



## Cayenne RED

Popular, attractive long, thin tapered fruit. Ripens green to red. Good hot flavour. Prolific all-rounder.



## Cayenne YELLOW

Slightly twisted, long, thick tapered red fruit. Popular. Heavy yielding.





# CHILLI

## EARLY JALAPENO



Early medium hot, suited to cooler areas with short Summers. Ripen green (mild) to red (hotter), sweet thick flesh



## FATALLI

Related to Habanero. Very attractive, fine yellow fruit. Very prolific. Complex flavour. Starts sweet & fruity then becomes very hot & punchy.



## HABANERO RED

Small but fiery. Masses of roundish green fruit, 2-6cm, ripen to red. Can tolerate more acidic soils than other chillies. Prefers hot Summers.



## HABANERO yellow



Small but fiery. Masses of roundish green fruit, 2-6cm, ripen to red. Can tolerate more acidic soils than other chillies. Prefers hot Summers.



## JOE'S LONG CAYENNE

Very long red chilli, mild when seeds are removed or medium heat with seeds in.



## MAUI PURPLE

Slender, compact, dark green-purple bush with small, slender purple fruit, later ripening to deep red. Very hot and sweet. Good for pots. Our favourite.



## PADRON



"Russian roulette" of chillies. Mostly mild but occasionally can be hot (dependent on growing conditions). Large, 8cm thick, tapered. High yield.



## PUYA

10cm hot, smooth tapered chilli with rich fruity flavour. Popular in Mexican dishes.



## RED CAP MUSHROOM

Attractive plant with squash-shaped, lime green fruit, ripening to bright red. Aromatic & hot. Good for balcony pots.



## ROGOTO

(AKA MANZANO)



A good cool climate choice. The perennial bush is hardier than most, can withstand Tas Winters & grow to 2m. Can live 10-15 years. Large, apple-shaped hot, orange-red chillies with black seeds.



## ROYAL BLACK

Slender, compact, dark green-purple bush with 1cm rounded purple fruit, later ripening to deep red. Very hot and sweet. Good for pots.



## SERRANO

Looks like a thinner jalapeno but 4 times as hot. Green to red (hotter). Medium thick juicy flesh.



# CAPSICUM

## ALMA PAPRIKA



Hungarian favourite, thick, sweet and fleshy. Around the size of a large button mushroom. Ground for paprika.

## Anatoli Romanian

The earliest of all. Sweet. Adapted to outdoor, cooler temperatures. Yellow, orange, red blocky fruit on sturdy, upright bush.



## Californian WONDER

Classic large, sweet bell, emerald green ripening to ruby. Very popular heirloom.



## CHINESE GIANT



Huge, sweet bells, emerald green ripening to ruby

## sweet CUBANELLE

One of the prettiest and easiest varieties to grow. It is a prolific, yellowy green colour ripening to red. Grows 6 cm across and 18 cm long.



## GILBOA ORANGE

Large, glossy, bright orange bell-shaped fruit. Highly pest resistant. Thick, sweet, succulent flesh.



# CAPSICUMS

## HUNGARIAN Yellow Wax

10cm long tapered green to yellow when mature. Sweet, mild waxy flesh. Not suited to cold areas.



## purple BEAUTY

Sturdy, compact plants. Fruit starts emerald green, ripens to midnight black then a beautiful purple. Harvest black or later red.



## Sweet BANANA

Early variety, tolerant of a wide range of temperatures. High yields of long tapered fruit 20cm long, yellow ripening to red



## Sweet Chocolate

Succulent, sweet long fruit, halfway between bell and classic tapered shape. Quick easy growing, prolific. Rich chocolate colour.



## WHITE diamond

A beautiful warm creamy white bell capsicum, ripening to soft golden peach, then finally red. Thick, sweet flesh. Love it!



# PUMPKIN

## AUSTRALIAN butter

Pale orange skin with fine-flavoured sweet, orange flesh. Stores well.



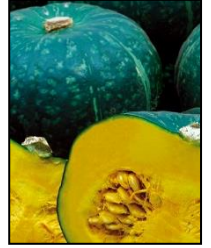
## BOHEMIAN

Green, yellow skin, dense, rich, sweet flesh. Some variability in shape.



## BUTTERCUP

We love this pumpkin. Rich, sweet, dense flesh. A good-sized pumpkin for an average family to use. Long storing.



## DUTCH crookneck

An amazingly curved ancestor of the Butternut. Very sweet flesh. All the seeds are stored at one end, making it ideal for low-fuss cooking.



## ironbark

Australian heirloom, very long storing. Very rough skin with dense, bright orange flesh. Sweet & delicious when baked.



## JARRAHDALÉ

Excellent pumpkin sweet flavour. Grows best in sunny, well drained soil.



## QUEENSLAND BLUE

Large, round, heavily ribbed. Thick blue skin with rich orange flesh. A long storing Australian favourite.



## TURK'S TURBAN

A curiously shaped fruit, striped with orange, white and green. No two are the same.



## WALTHAM BUTTERNUT

A prized heirloom Butternut. Classically shaped fruit with a small seed cavity. Soft yellow flesh and a great nutty flavour.



## PINK BANANA JUMBO

Bright pink skin with brilliant yellow flesh. A reasonably small seed cavity. Great pumpkin taste. They store great for months and don't lose their flavour.





# SQUASH

## GEM

South Africa. Space saving, compact vine with grapefruit-sized fruit. Can be eaten fresh or stored as a mini-sized pumpkin for roasting. Sweet when small, savoury when large & mature



## JAUNE et verte

Compact variety producing scalloped fruit over a long period. Sweet, buttery flesh when picked small. Tender skin cooks to lime green.



## SPAGHETTI

A vegetable with a difference. Long strands of flesh resemble spaghetti and can be used as such with a dash of olive oil, herbs and a bit of imagination.



# CUCUMBER

## Armenian

Pale burpless fruit with refreshing citrusy flavour. Drier flesh stores up to 1 month. Best picked at 30cm



## CONTINENTAL

Popular, slender, long, sweetly flavoured. Grows well in Tas.



## Japanese CLIMBING

Early, juicy, crisp fruit. Prolific fruiting on trellis. Our new favourite.



## Lebanese

Prolific, popular, short, dark green, sweet, crisp, burpless. Prefers full sun. Copes well with heat. Best when 15-20cm long. Strong, firm, thin skin.



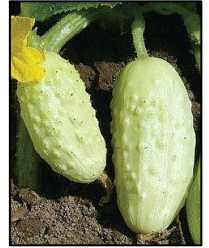
## little POTATO

Like a rough, alabaster-textured potato, with zesty lemon flesh. A beautiful & tasty treat.



## mini white

10cm long fruit, best used young. This is great for both fresh and pickled. A favourite



## SUYO LONG

Originated in Northern China. Long, ribbed, dark green fruit can grow to 18 inches. Mild and sweet flavour.



# ZUCCHINI

## BLACK Beauty

Pick flowers for stuffing or leave fruit to 15cm. Heavy cropping.



## costata

Beautiful, prolific, Italian heavily ribbed variety. Looks like stars when sliced. Firm, crisp flesh. Early harvest. Our favourite zucchini.



## GOLDEN

Very quick & easy. Sunshine-yellow fruit is ready in 9 weeks from transplant..



## Lebanese

Tasty, pale green fruit, best picked small (finger-size) but can mature to almost 1m. Bulge at flower end makes them ideal for stuffing. Very prolific. Disease resistant.



## LONG FLORENCE

Big flowers that can be stuffed. Olive-green ribbed fruit. Long harvest. Italy.



## TROMBONCINO

Spectacular zucchini with outstanding flavour. Grow up to 1m but best picked at 25cm. Train up a trellis for straight fruit or leave on ground for some amazing shapes. Mature fruit stores well for several months. High yielding.



# ROCKMELON

## Ananas

Sweet & fragrant, with pineapple undertone. Excellent yields over long period.



## eden's GEM

Small fruit with rough grey skin & green-orange flesh, very sweet & refreshing. Cool climate variety, 17 fruit/vine.



## French charentais

High yielding, delicately scented French favourite



## HA-OGEN

Shiny smooth yellow skin subtly striped with tinges of green. Incredibly sweet, green flesh. (Hungary).



## KAZAKH

Scalloped leaves. Skin with distinctive yellow tint & mottled green texture. Incredibly sweet, pale flesh, green towards the rind. 14 fruit/vine. (Kazakhstan)



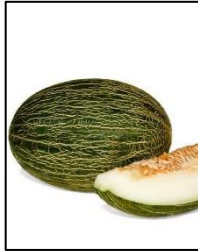
## MINNESOTA midget

Early, space saver (1msq). Sweet, rich flesh on compact, prolific vine. 18 fruit/vine.



## PIEL DE SAPO

The *Santa Claus* or *Christmas melon*, originating in Spain. Best eaten after sitting uncut at room temperature for 2 days. Sweet and soft.



## SWEET GRANITE

Perfect for cool Summers. Highly productive over a short period, producing masses of fruit on compact vines. Classic Rockmelon with sweet, orange flesh.



# WATERMELON

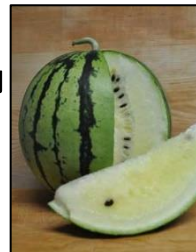
## BLACKTAIL MOUNTAIN

The most cold-tolerant of watermelons. Yields dark green cannonball-like 5kg fruit. Sweet, succulent, red flesh.



## CREAM OF SASKATCHEWAN

Green skin with white stripes on round fruit. Juicy, cream-coloured flesh. Very sweet & early maturing.



## MOUNTAIN SWEET YELLOW

Large, elongated fruit with yellow flesh. Sweet, refreshing honey flavour. Highly productive.



## SWEET SIBERIAN

Very early (10 weeks). Sweet & fragrant with juicy orange flesh. Good for cooler climates.

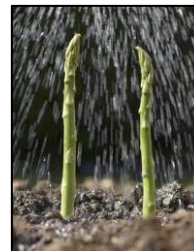
